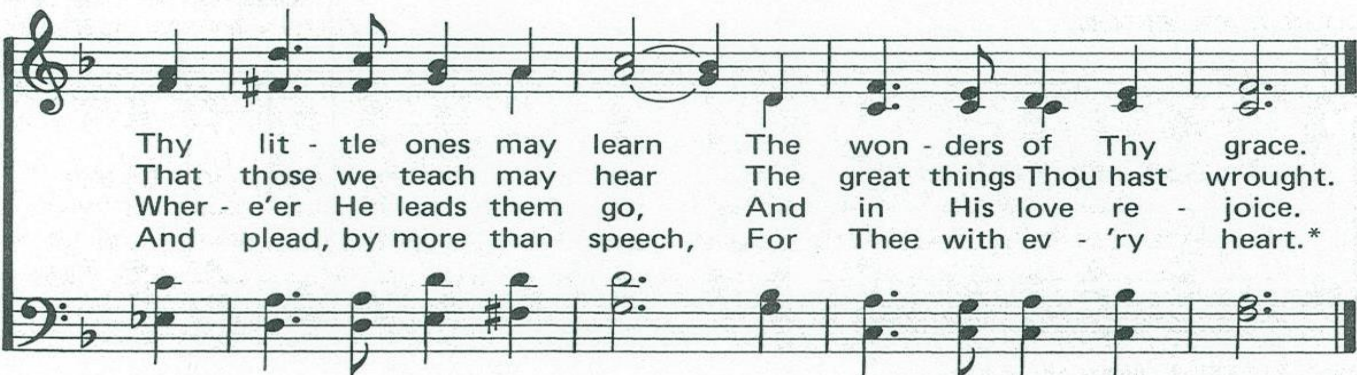
1. Shine Thou up - on us, Lord, True light of men to - day,
