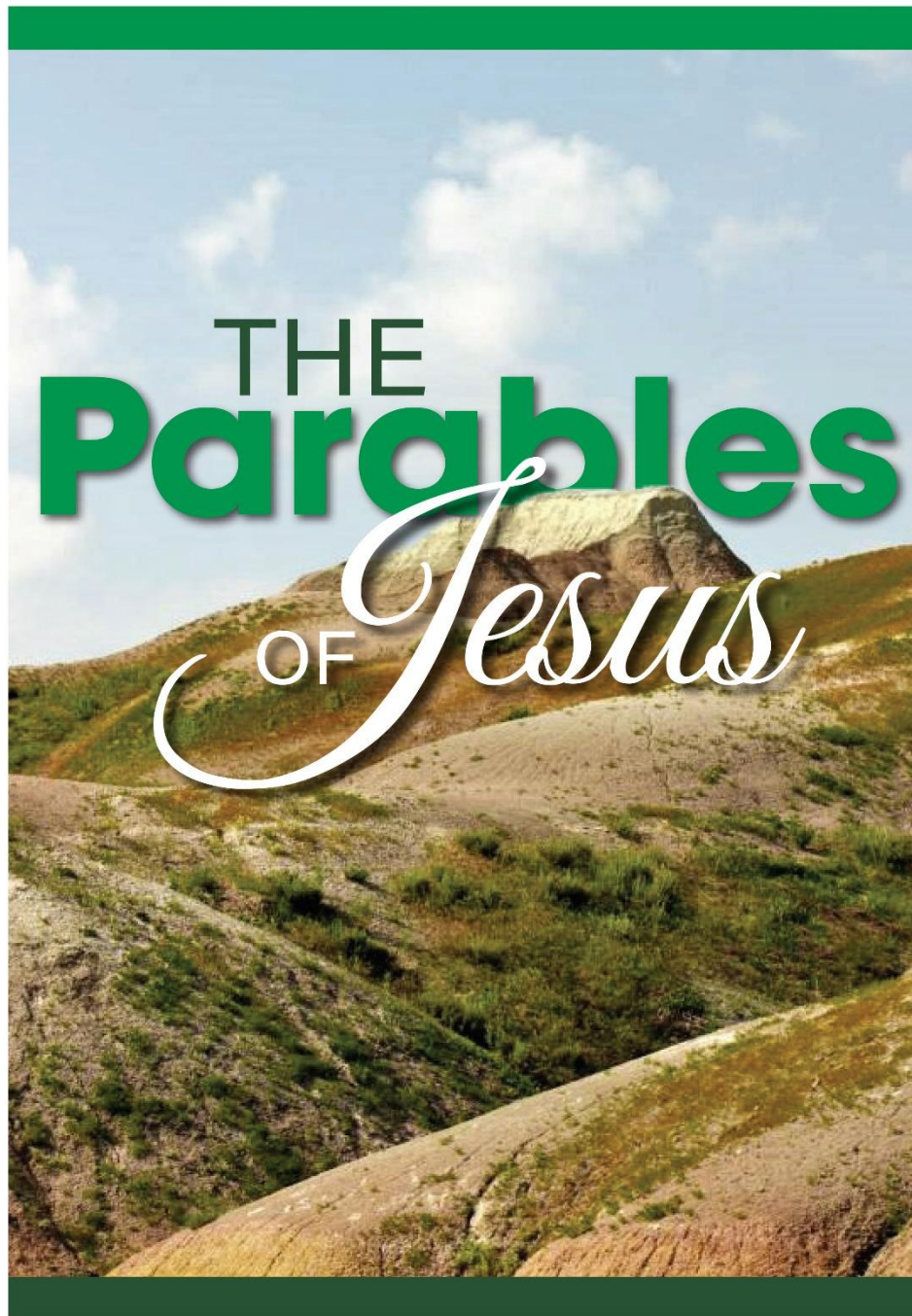

There is no Sunday School today. Our focus is on worship and fellowship.

Sunday Worship

Morning Worship 10:45am – We will continue to worship the Lord for giving us his church. This week we reflect on Christ's church as a conquering church. In church history, all living believers were called "the Church militant" as opposed to all deceased believers, named the "Church Triumphant."

In our sermon, we hear the first of our Parable of Kingdom Living. Today, the Lord teaches us a crucial Christian virtue.

6pm Evening Worship – We will honor fathers in the evening worship service "ACT LIKE MEN, BE STRONG" is the scripture in I Corinthians 16:13. What does it mean to be a biblical man? All the family needs to understand what the Bible teaches about the identity of men. We want to honor fathers and men on this day; and also, challenge men to be men.
