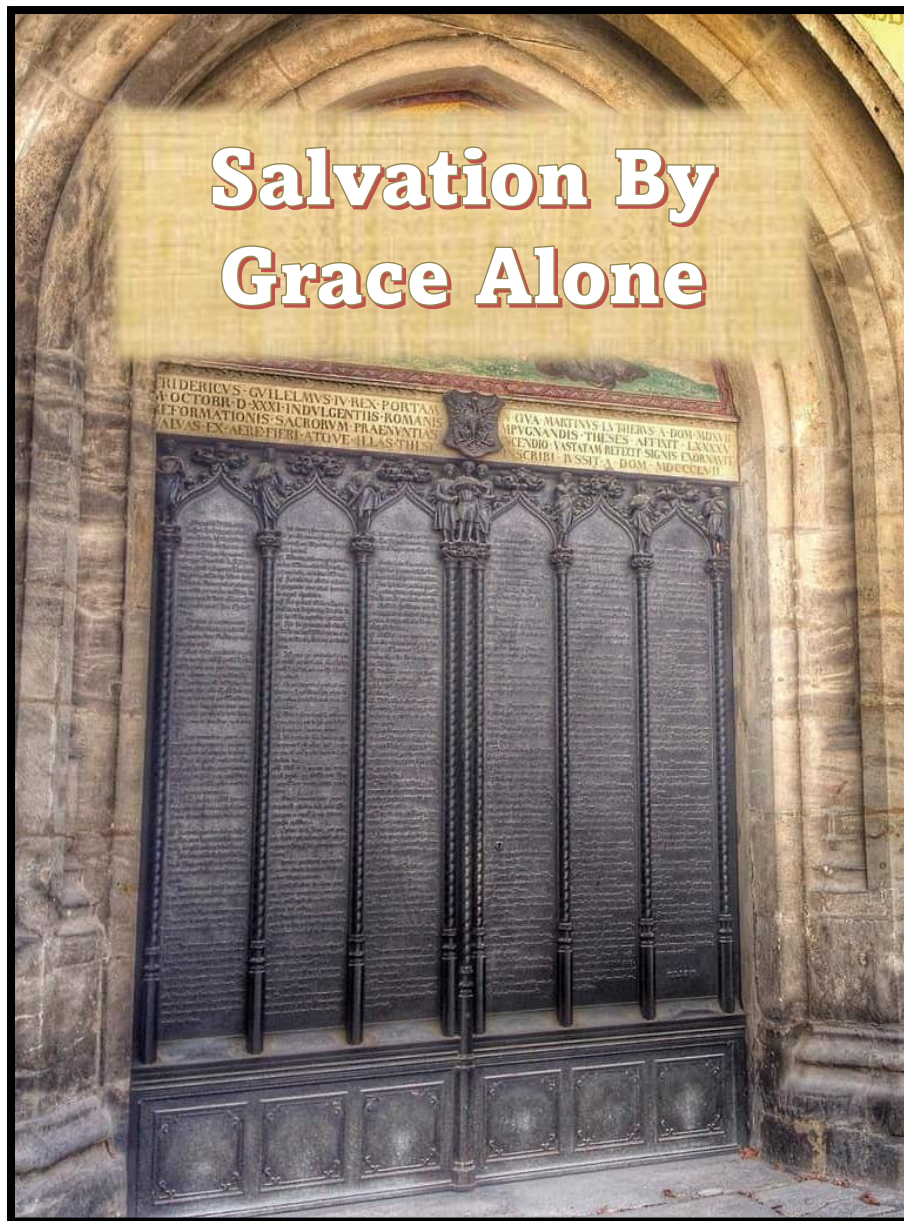


Salvation By Grace Alone

- 3) **The Two Pigeons** (5:7-13 and 14:21-22) = God offers restoration for _____ his people.

- 4) **The Meal Image** (‘food offering’ 6:17, 41x in Leviticus) = No full restoration with a _____ with God.

- 5) **The Pleasing Aroma** (6:15, 16x in Leviticus) = God grants _____
