For our sermon: With Leviticus' first major section on worship almost concluded, we will take an important diversion. We will ask what the Bible teaches about the kind of worship that brings God glory.

7pm Men's Bible Study -The men are studying "**Man of God**". Why Study Biblical manhood? There is a crisis of identity for modern men. Changes in the traditional roles of men and women have left many men wondering: What makes a real man? We will learn about our God-given role in creation, and how that has been ruined by the fall. We will discover how we can be restored through the man above all men – Jesus Christ.
