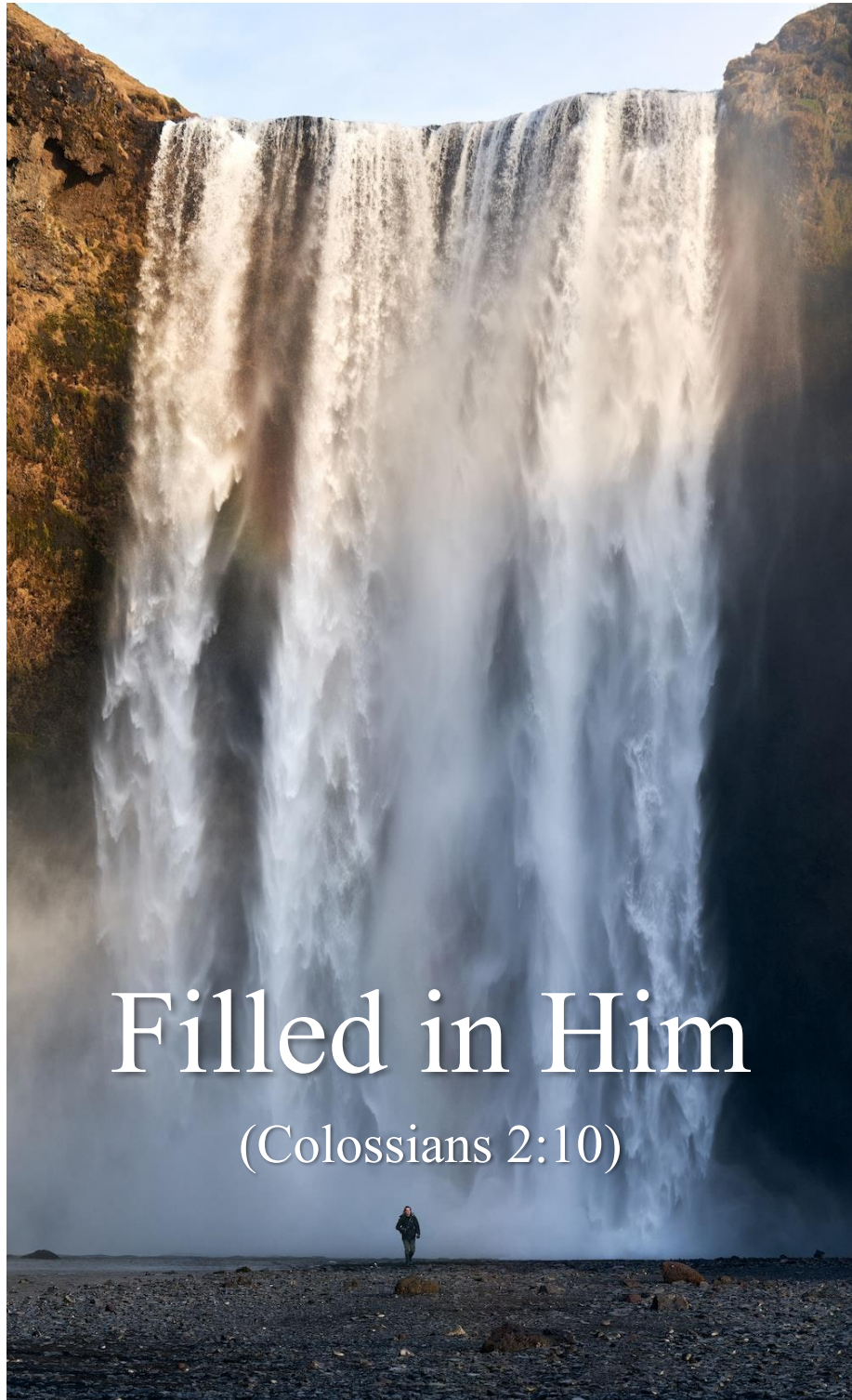

10:45am Worship Service – Why are we so regularly unsatisfied? Why does 'Fear Of Missing Out' drive and dominate our hearts? It is because human hearts long to be blessed and satisfied, and we also love to take the easy route. Yet the human heart is too deep for any created thing to fully bless and satisfy. Jesus says the blessing of his living water means you will "never be thirsty again" (John 4:13). This week, Ephesians starts a deep, long, pouring-out waterfall of amazing grace from God. What do the words of this one verse mean?
