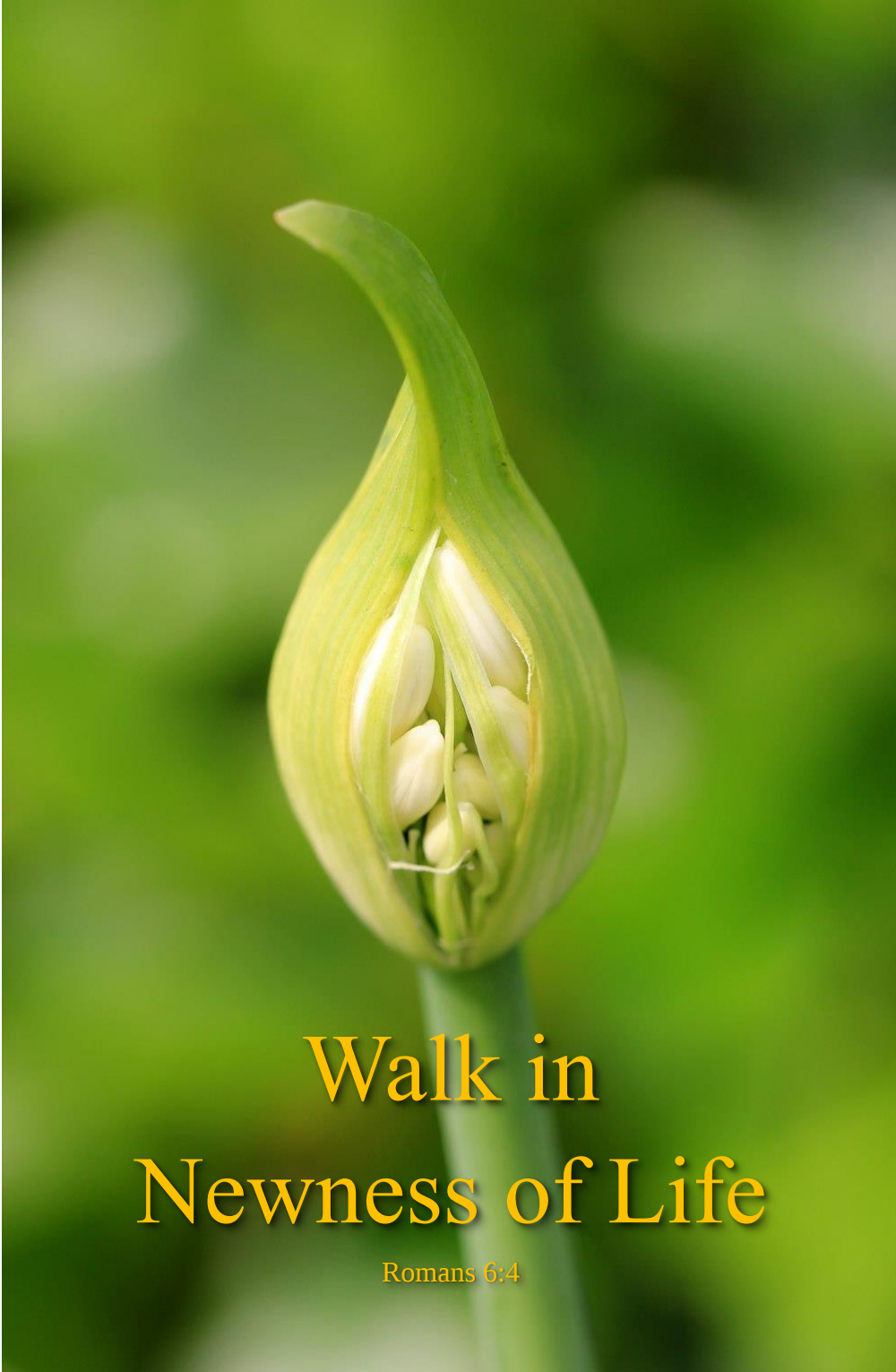

But what is God's way? Today is Ephesians 5:1-2, the first of three sections about Christian "walking." Today is to "walk in love." Here the Bible gives you two of the most simple, foundational directions for how to live your life morally. But what sets Christianity apart as the only true religion is the crucial reason why.
