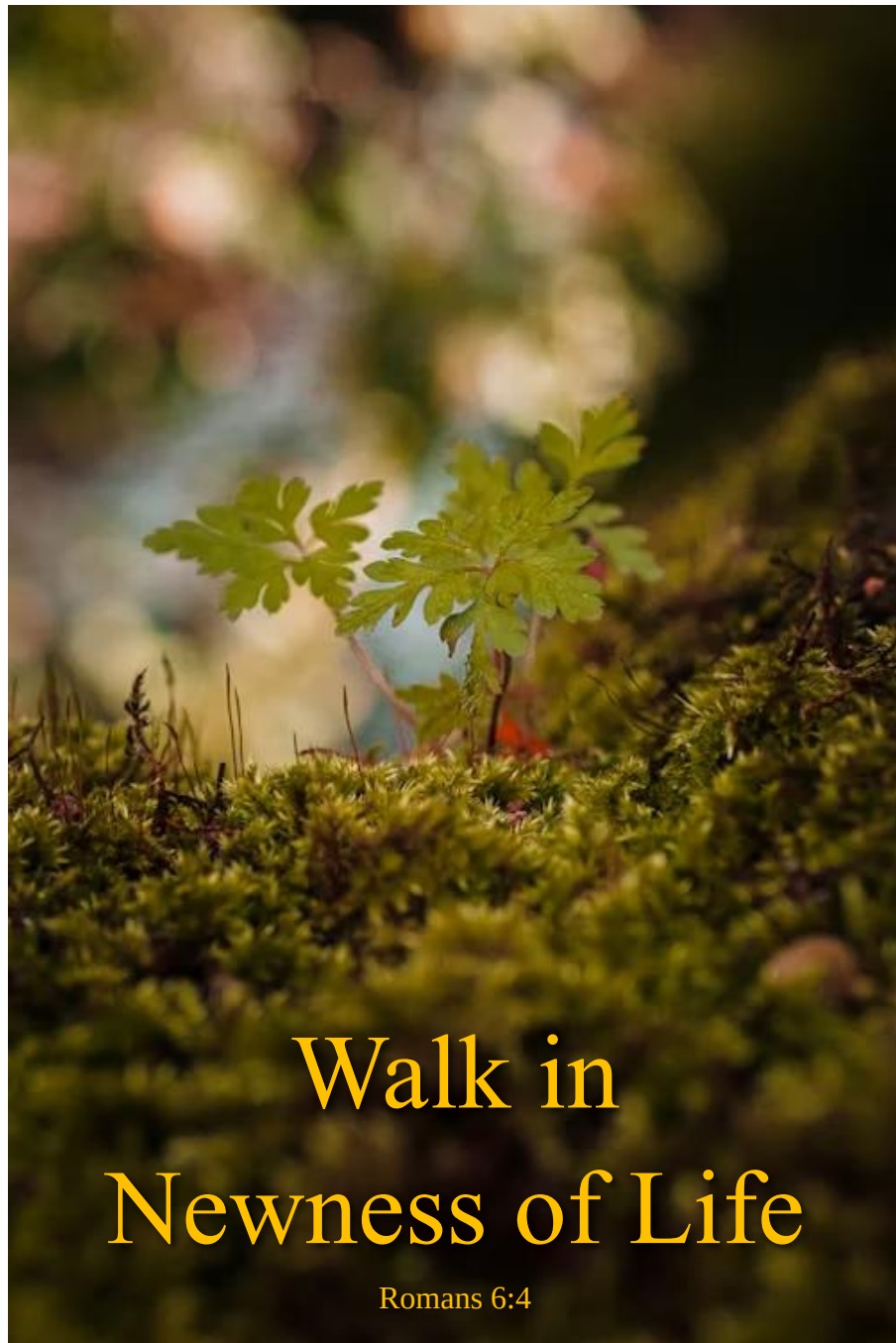

The Flow of the Psalms - Led by Tony Carroscia (Fellowship Hall) We often think of the Psalms as a random collection of songs and prayers.
