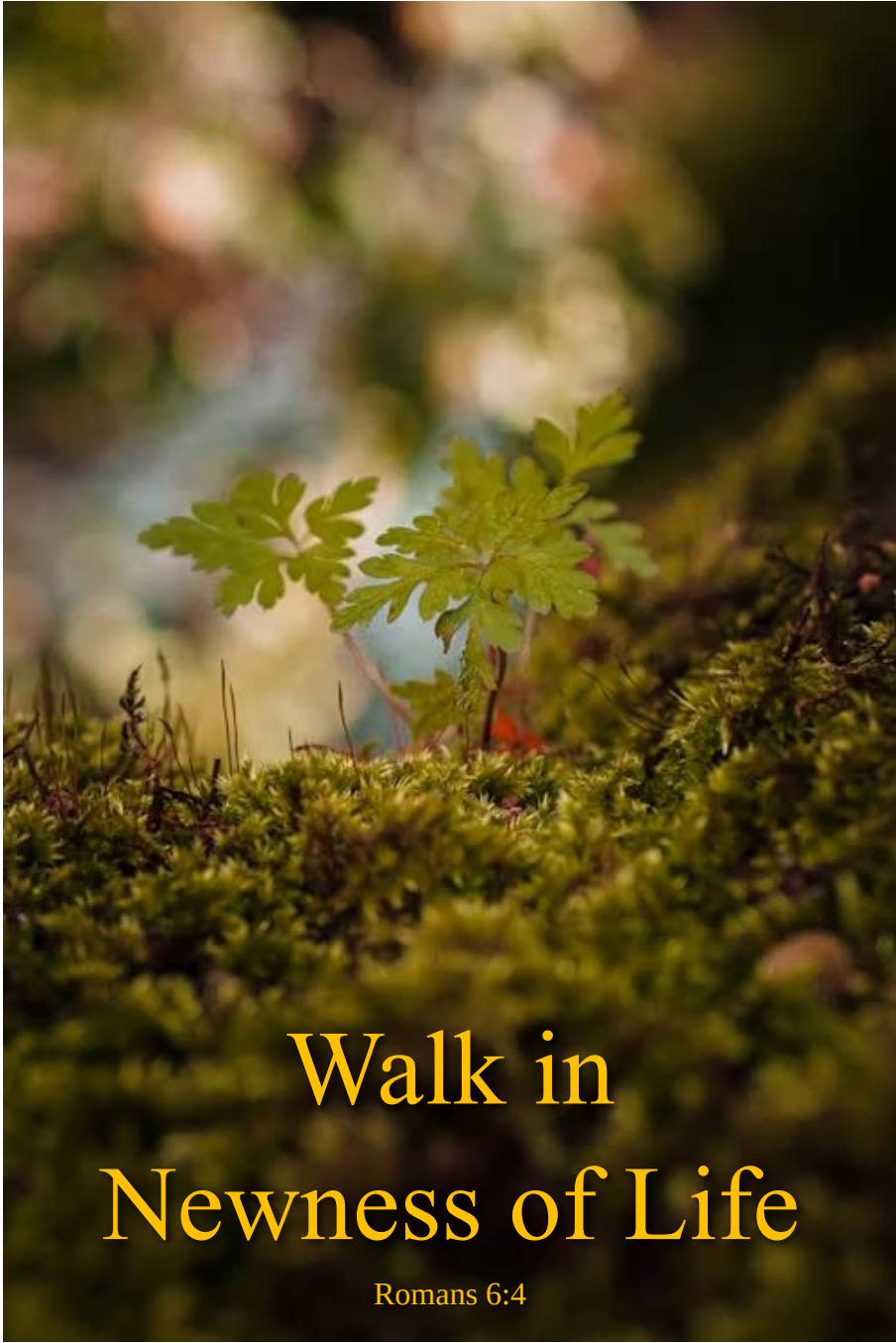

**Evangelism and the PCA: Facts and 5 Themes (Pastor Jeff)**

– Let's dismiss impressions and get down to some facts. "How is the PCA doing with evangelism?" And "What can we learn from those churches that are showing great fruitfulness in evangelism?" In this important one-off Sunday School class, Pastor Jeff will answer both those questions.
