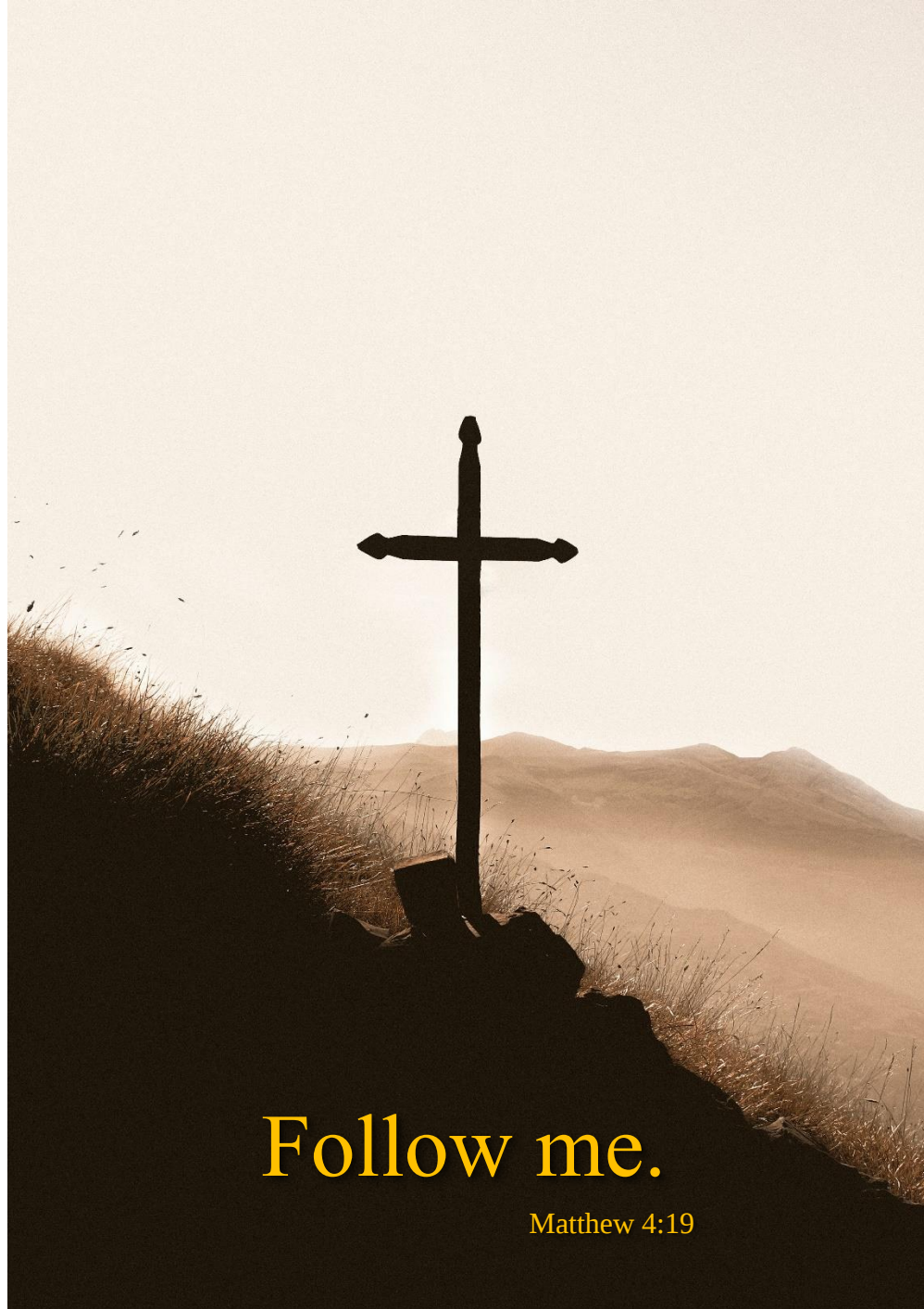

10:45am Morning Worship – The Jesus of history – what exactly did the Bible say he *did*? And who was he? In Matthew 4:12-25, Jesus' earthly ministry is summarized. First he continues to 'accidentally' fulfill prophecy with even smaller events (vv12-16 – of course, it was not accidental). Then, three stories show us what three things Jesus primarily did while on earth. Why will this matter? One reason is this: It is painfully common for people both inside and outside the church to reduce Jesus into one thing, while forgetting the *whole* Christ. We are called forth to follow the whole Christ!
