10:45am Morning Worship – Matthew 5:17-20 “Jesus Fulfills the Law.” Christians must grow in the knowledge of Jesus (2 Peter 3:18). And anyone who lives long enough as a Christian will have to sort out how Jesus relates to the laws of the Bible. Do all laws apply today, like the death penalty for adulterers, the food laws of Leviticus, or that we shall not steal? And if some do not, how do we answer the charge that we are just picking and choosing laws by our own taste? Some teachers today say we should “unhitch” from *all* Old Testament law. Is that what we should do?

This Sunday you will learn three different and important ways that these words are fulfilled: *“Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.”* (Matthew 5:17). Here is another passage that shows: Jesus is amazing.
