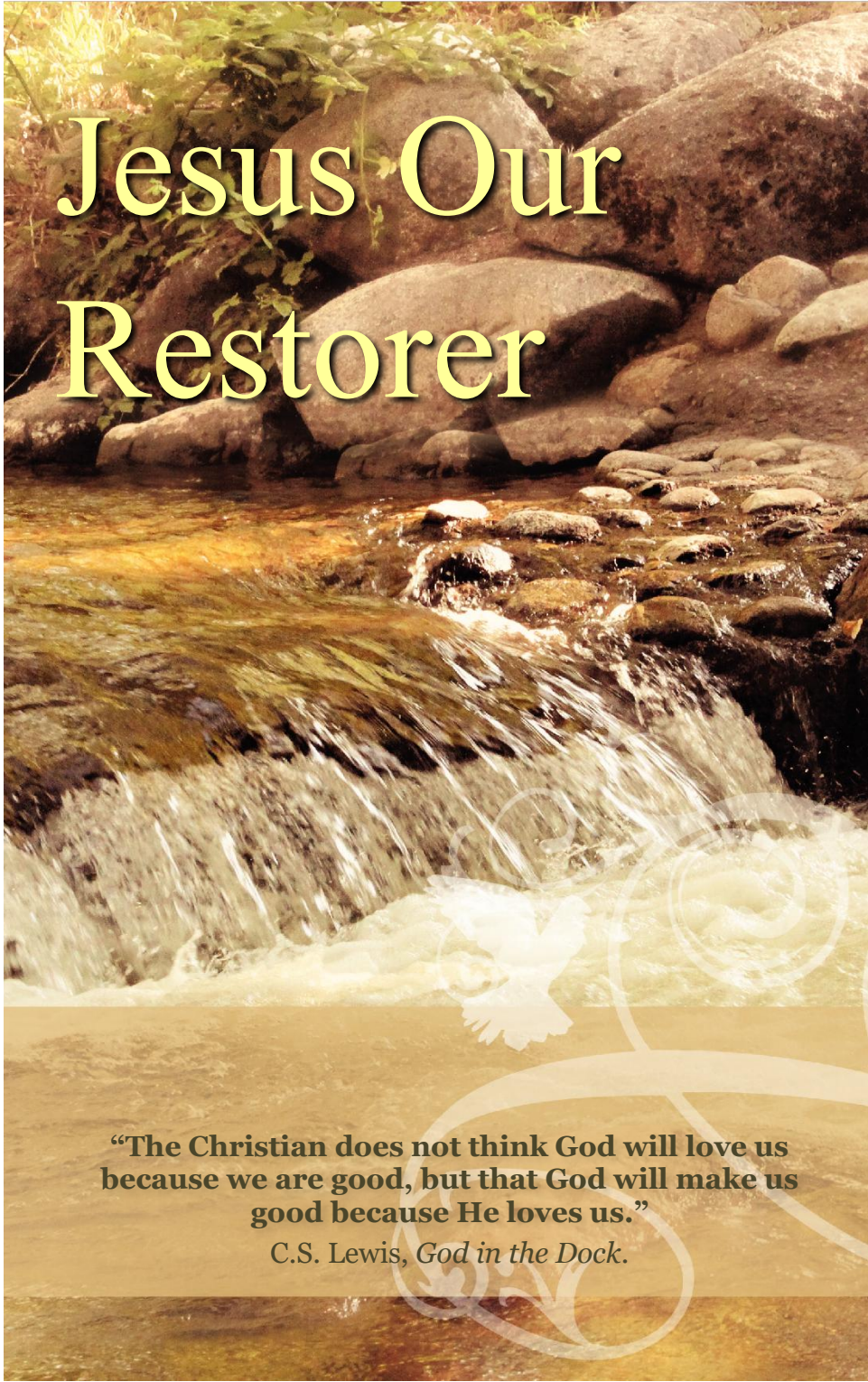

Sunday Worship

10:45am Outdoor Morning Worship Service – This morning we gather to keep the Sabbath holy. And on this Lord's Day, we remember the gospel: Jesus Christ before he lived and died, came to call sinners to himself. Matthew 9:9-13, "The Company the Disciple-Maker Kept." And the mission isn't complete: Jesus is still calling sinners to himself.

After Worship Luncheon – Stay after and enjoy a luncheon and a time of fellowship. And bring an appetite!

2pm Kids Campers & SSB Campers will be leaving for camp. "Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord" (2 Corinthians 10:17).

(No Evening Worship) – What can I do to finish out the Lord's Day? Here are 5 suggestions: (a) Invite a church friend or family for dinner, especially one who you may not yet know well. (b) Make a connection with nonchurched neighbors – say hello, or bring over a surprise baked treat. (c) Set apart 15-30 minutes for family devotion or family worship (ask questions about the sermon for example, like "What did the Bible passage teach about God?" and "What did it teach about man?" and "What am I taking away for this week?"). (d) Enjoy creation with friends or family. Or (e) Retreat by yourself – Give yourself an extended time of individual devotion with the Lord, in the Word or in prayer for others. May we call the Sabbath a delight (Isa. 58:13).
