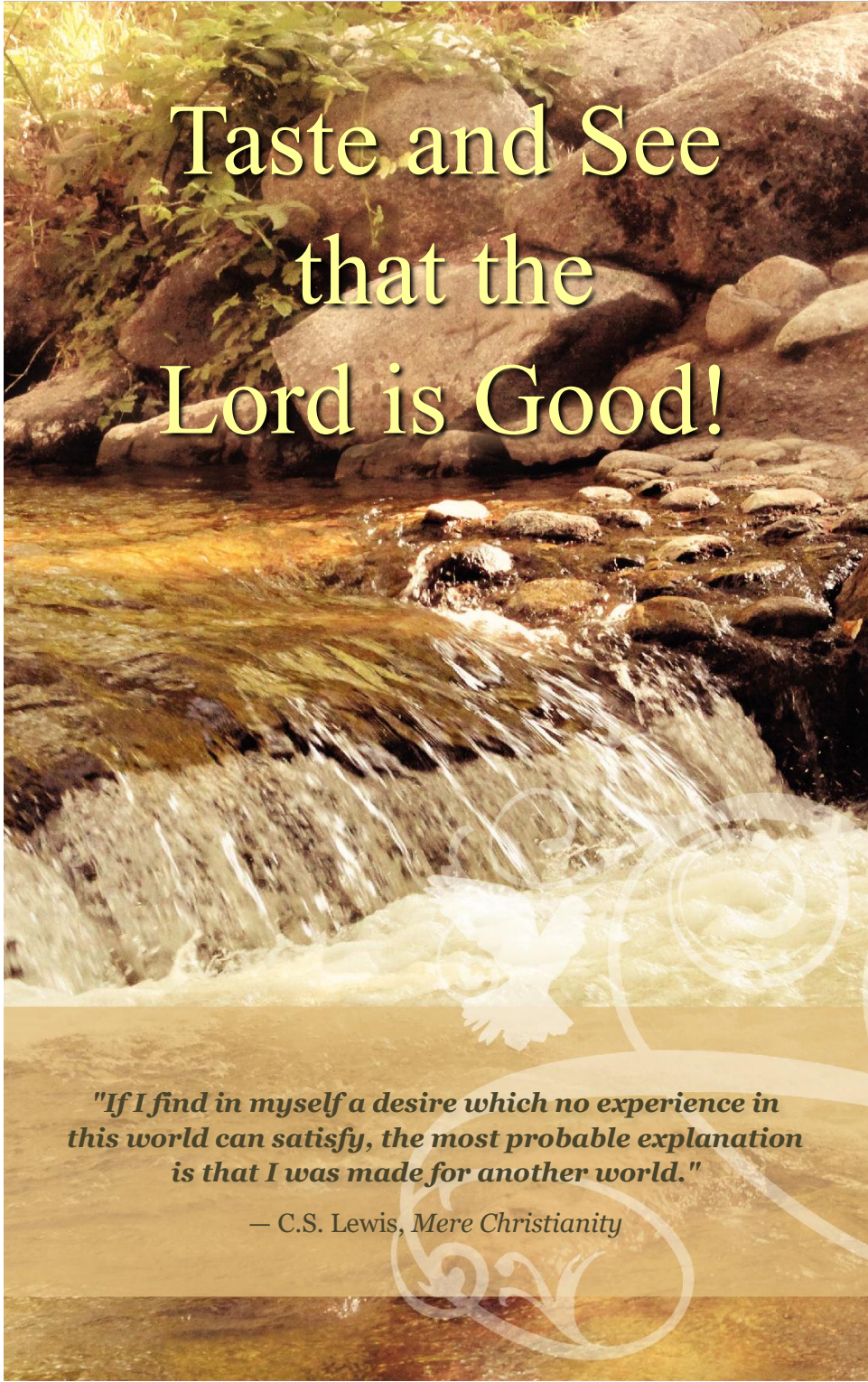

This week, Pastor Jeff Zehnder is back and preaching from Matthew 9:14-17 "A New Wineskin – Jesus Brings a New Order." If Jesus brings a whole new order in him, then one's moral life will have to adjust around him, too.

After Worship Luncheon – Stay after and enjoy a luncheon and a time of fellowship. And bring an appetite!

(No Evening Worship) – Let us call the Sabbath a delight (Isa. 58:13). What can I do to finish out the Lord's Day? Here are 5 suggestions: (a) Invite a church friend or family for dinner, especially one who you may not yet know well. (b) Make a connection with nonchurched neighbors – say hello, or bring over a baked treat. (c) Set apart 15-30 minutes for family devotion or family worship (ask questions about the sermon for example, like "What did the Bible passage teach about God?" and "What did it teach about man?" and "What am I taking away for this week?"). (d) Enjoy creation with friends or family. Or (e) Retreat by yourself – an extended time of individual devotion with the Lord, in the Word or in prayer for others.

10:45am Morning Worship – Next week, Pastor Jeff will be preaching from Matthew 9:18-34 "Jesus responds to faith." Jesus is approached by a woman with a 12-year blood discharge and by two blind men, and both are identified by their "*faith*" in Jesus (V22, V29). Jesus also heals a mute man, but the opposite of faith is found when the Pharisees condemn him for casting out demons 'by the prince of demons' (V34). The opposite of faith here isn't doubt; it's opposition to Christ. Next week we examine faith. How is your faith in Christ?

6pm Evening service – We close our Sunday with worship, with favorite hymns and prayers.
