6pm Evening Worship – Prophecies of Victory and Restoration (Revelation 19-22). Jesus's final return gives great hope and focus for all in times of bliss or burden. Next Sunday night, we open a very disputed subject in recent Christian history: **the Millennium**. You will learn about all the views, and questions are encouraged. We might take 2 Sunday nights on this. But, unlike most who get lost in the important timelines, we will not lose sight of the passage's main point: "Victory over Satan" (Revelation 20:1-10). What does the Bible actually teach about the end of time?
